Information about cookies & similar technologies

This policy contains information about cookies and similar technologies in connection with your use of VideoOnPaper sites and mobile applications that link to it (collectively our "Sites").

What are cookies and similar technologies?

A cookie is a small text file that is placed on your computer, mobile phone, or other device when you visit a website. We use these cookies to analyze how our Sites are accessed, used or performing. We use this information to maintain, operate and continually improve our Sites. We may also obtain information from our Email newsletters, to learn whether you opened or forwarded the newsletter or clicked on any of the content. This information tells us about our newsletters' effectiveness and helps us ensure that we're delivering information that you find interesting. We use Google Analytics as one of our providers. Functional

These cookies let us operate certain functions of our Sites in line with the choices you make. These cookies mean that when you continue to use or come back to our Sites, we can recognize you as a registered customer and customize your experience, such as knowing your name and email address, remembering the types of products or services you previously ordered or reviewed, and providing recommendations on the products or services that may be of interest to you.
